Born in California and representing the United States before switching to China, teenager Gu Ailing will be most likely to be one of the faces of the 2022 Beijing Winter Olympics.

The 17-year-old is a freeskier(自由式滑雪运动员) and grade-A student with an American father and Chinese mother. She grew up and still lives in the United States, but in June 2019 she made the "quite difficult" decision to compete for China. She wrote on Instagram that she was "proud of my heritage and equally proud of my American upbringings (培养)".

As for the decision to compete on behalf of China, she said it is "valuable opportunity to help inspire millions of young people in China where my mom was born."

Gu graduated from a San Francisco high school last year and is focusing on her Beijing 2022 training. It is reported that She scored 1,580 points out of a maximum 1,600 in the SAT (美国大学入学考试), and has been offered a place at Stanford.

Gu started on the snow at the age of 3, was competing in national competitions at 9 and won her first World Cup event at 15. She won two gold medals and a silver for China at the 2020 Youth Olympic Games in Lausanne, Switzerland. On Jan. 30th, 2021, Gu made her debut(首次亮相) at the X Games in Aspen, Colorado and won two golds and a bronze.

achievement. And that would be rewarding for all the work that I've done to achieve greatness in the sport."

A small bowl bought at a yard sale in Connecticut for just \$35 has been identified as a rare 15th—century Chinese antique.

The blue—and—white bowl was made by China's royal court during the Ming dynasty. is now expected to sell for up to \$500, 000, according to Sotheby's auction(拍卖) house in New York, where the auction will take place next month.

The purchase was made last year near New Haven, Connecticut. "I was just hanging around there aimlessly. But when I saw this bowl, I didn't even bargain over the \$35 asking price, "the owner said. Shortly after the purchase, he sent photos of the bowl to auction specialists, who identified it as an item of historical significance.

Upon closer inspection, the artifact was found to have originated from the period of the Yongle Emperor, who ruled from 1402 to 1424 — a period noted for its distinctive porcelain(瓷 器) techniques. It's now valued between \$300,000 and \$500,000, with the top estimate nearly

- 14, 300 times the amount it was purchased for.
- "I was deeply attracted by the techniques. You can see why this bowl is so highly—valued from the very smooth porcelain body, silky glaze (釉料) and special blue colouring, which were never reproduced in later dynasties,"McAteer, an auction specialist, said.

"The Yongle Emperor improved the porcelain techniques and elevated the importance of porcelain from being an ordinary bowl into a true work of art. This small bowl has both practical and artistic value, "McAteer said.

One possible version:

The taxi stops in front of the Police Station and Arthur thanks the driver and directly goes in. Just as Arthur is describing what happens near the bank on the Park Avenue and reports the young man to the police, he hears a voice outside, "Help! Help!" To the surprise of Arthur, it is the young man. He follows Arthur in another taxi. It turns out that the young man is innocent and inside the suitcases are just some clothes. Arthur feels embarrassed but the policemen thank him anyway.
